Hearts for Israel Prayer Tour • March 12-21 2012 • Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day 1, Monday, March 12 – Depart from Home

Fly from Indianapolis or your nearest airport to catch the early evening flight (Delta flight 0268 at 7:25 p.m.) from New York's JFK Airport to Tel Aviv. After take-off, have dinner and sleep through the flight, eating breakfast before arrival in Tel Aviv.

Day 2, Tuesday, March 13 – Arrive in Israel, Go Up to Jerusalem!

Afternoon arrival at Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv. After going through passport control, collect your luggage and proceed as a group through customs. Meet our guide and driver and load up on a luxury coach to enjoy the scenic ride to "Go Up to Jerusalem!" We'll go to the Western Wall and pray before we go to view the City of the Great King from the Mt. of Olives. Go to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 3, Wednesday, March 14 – Jerusalem: Worship and Intercession:

After a sumptuous Israeli buffet breakfast, go for a prayer walk on the Temple Mount, then spend a time of worship and intercession at Succat Hallel one of the ministries God has raised up in Jerusalem to cover the Land in prayer 24/7. Go to the Jewish Quarter for lunch and shopping on your own. See the Cardo, the ancient Roman street in the heart of Jerusalem. Visit the Davidson Center and Southern Steps of the Temple, where Jesus would have often taught. Visit the End-Time Handmaidens and Servants House of Peace for a time of prayer and fellowship. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 4, Thursday, March 15 – Judea and Samaria Prayer Day:

Drive into Judea and Samaria to visit Shiloh where the tabernacle rested for 369 years and where Samuel was trained. Pray over the Biblical Heartland of Israel where God made most of the covenants with the patriarchs. Pray over the Mountains of Israel mentioned in Ezekiel 38 and 39. In the afternoon, return to Jerusalem and visit Yad VaShem, the memorial to the 6 million who lost their lives in the Holocaust. View the Knesset and pray for Israel at the Menorah. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Friday, March 16 – Jerusalem in the Footsteps of Our Saviour:

Visit Gethsemane where Jesus agonized and prayed the prayer of relinquishment. Continue to the Church of St. Peter en Gallicantu built on the site of Caiphas' House, where Jesus was imprisoned and Peter denied Him. Then pray in the Upper Room, site of the Last Supper and the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Visit the Pools of Bethesda just inside the Lion's (St. Stephen's) Gate and worship in the lovely Crusader Church of St. Anne. View Golgotha and enter the empty Garden Tomb, and celebrate Holy Communion together. Feel the Sabbath begin to quiet the city. Drive south past the Dead Sea to Biblical Tamar Park to our overnight accommodations. Welcome the Sabbath and enjoy dinner and overnight in the quietness of the desert.

Saturday, March 17 – The Desert and Dead Sea

Wake up in the Aravah, the Judean Wilderness on the edge of the Negev Desert. Tour Biblical Tamar Park, a rare stop on most tour itineraries. Drive to Masada and go up the cable car to hike around the last stronghold of the Zealots. From the Field School, view Ein Gedi where David hid from Saul and hopefully see some of the wild goats for which the spring is named. Take a dip in the Dead Sea and discover

that you cannot sink in its mineral-rich waters. Stop at Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found and learn about the Essene Community of priests that dedicated themselves to holiness while the corrupt priesthood ran the Temple in Jesus' time. View and pray over the Mountains of Moab in the nation of Jordan on the opposite side of the Dead Sea. Drive North through the Jordan Valley to the Sea of Galilee and our Kibbutz. Dinner and overnight at the Kibbutz.

Day 7, Sunday, March 18 – Walking Where Jesus Walked:

Begin the day with a visit to "The Jesus' Boat" at Kibbutz Nof Ginosar and shop at their store. Worship on a Sea of Galilee Boat Ride. Visit Capernaum and the Mount of Beatitudes and you'll begin to understand why Jesus spent so much time in the Galilee. Enjoy an opportunity to enjoy a lunch of St. Peter's fish (not included in tour price) Drive to Porriya to visit the End-Time Handmaidens and Servants Galilee House for a time of prayer and fellowship. Drive to Yardenit, for an opportunity to be baptized in the Jordan River. Drive around the Sea of Galilee to our Kibbutz for dinner and overnight.

Day 8, Monday, March 19 – Northern Borders Prayer Day:

Drive up on the Golan Heights to pray over the Syrian border at the Valley of the Tears where God intervened with miracles in a tank battle in the 1973 Yom Kippur War. Look into Syria and pray over the border with Israel's deadliest enemy. Pray into God's Sovereignty over Israel and the Nations. Drive up to Banias/Caesarea Philippi where Peter declared that Jesus was the Messiah and pray over the waters that form part of the Jordan River, Israel's main water supply. Drive by Tel Dan, the ruins of the ancient city that was the northernmost point of Biblical Israel's tribes. Drive along the Lebanese border to Rosh Hanikra, the northernmost point of Israel on the Mediterranean Coast. Pray over the waters where Israel has discovered natural gas fields and bless them as they drill, "because the abundance of the sea shall be converted unto [them]" (Is. 60:5). Return to our kibbutz for dinner and overnight.

Day 9, Tuesday, March 20 – Western Galilee and Sharon Region:

Drive past Mt. Tabor and through the Jezreel Valley to Megiddo and pray over the valley where the Battle of Armageddon will be fought. Drive to Mount Carmel to the Muhraka, where we remember how Elijah and the prophets of Baal found out that our God answers by fire! Enjoy the magnificent view of miles and miles of the Land and pray for Israel from this strategic location. Drive to Caesarea on the shores of the Mediterranean to view the Roman amphitheater and Herod's Palace where Paul was imprisoned and see the Roman aqueduct. Then to Old Jaffa to take a leisurely walk through its beautiful, winding streets. Join in a final farewell dinner for a time of sharing the highlights of your Israel experience in Tel Aviv and transfer to the Ben Gurion Airport for our return flight.

Day 10, Wednesday, March 21 – Welcome Home!

Have an early morning arrival (6:15 a.m. on Delta flight 0269) at JFK Airport to make connections to fly home.
